

You will never sink!

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

- James 4: 6



The origin of the family began when God created Adam and Eve. Family plays a vital role in everyone's life. Every household falls in the plan of God to reveal His glory.

In the times of the early church, there was literature called "household texts". Apostle Paul in his letters to the churches speaks about individual households and larger households. He gives specific guidelines for the household of God- the whole church.

> Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

> > **Ephesians 5: 22, 25**

The purpose of the individual household texts was to give a clear picture of the guidelines for life as a family, especially in light of how those families were to live in the community. Paul and Peter used the format of their culture to explain how families of Christians were to live within the church- God's family. We could see that there are three individual household texts in the New Testament letters.

Ephesians 5:22-29, Colossians 3: 18-4-1 and 1 Peter 3: 1-7.

In a time when the guidelines for marriage and family life are being redefined in our culture, it is vital that we build our marriages and families upon God's design.

We could see Paul directly addresses each household member: wives, husbands, children, fathers, slaves and masters. Husbands are to love their Wives. Wives are to submit to their husbands. Children are to obey their parents. Slaves are to obey their masters and Fathers are to patiently train their children.

It is very important for each of us to know our responsibility in our family and submit to his or

her responsibility. God has blessed and placed us in our family with a big purpose and plan. Christ's plan centers on the church being a family of families.

The husband is to love his wife as much as Christ loves us, even

giving up his life for her. He is to cherish and nurture her. He is to give significant, patient attention to the development of his children.



God expects the families to be orderly for the church to function orderly. God created order to things, and when we follow His created order, families and churches work.

This is the hope a name can bring in one's life.







"The more heads, the bravest man" was their custom.

Many missionaries tried to reach out but ended up dead but one family - Nokseng and his family accepted God and they began spreading God's love among the head hunters.

The Chief of the tribe did not like it and called them in front of the whole village. He told Nokseng to deny God or he would kill his two sons. Nokseng loved his sons, but said,

"I have decided to follow Jesus, no turning back, no turning back."

The Chief ordered the sons to be killed.

As the dead sons lay before him, the Chief told him to deny God or he would kill his beloved wife. But Nokseng said,

What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it?


Luke 15: 4

"I am His and He is Mine"


When I look back, I saw his loving arms embracing me, saw Him carrying me in His arms through the difficult times and pain. Now I can boldly say "I am His and He is Mine".
