• Priscilla (Acts 18, Romans 16: 3 & 4, 2 Timothy 4: 19)



To swirl around this hope of mine!





When the colours of spring faded away It's the dew of new I see along the way Thence my soul said to Thine To swirl around this hope of mine!


### HISTORICAL FACT

# THE STORY BEHIND "IT IS WELL WITH MY SOUL"

In the 1800s, Horatio Gates Spafford was a lawyer and a wealthy man. He was fortunate to have five children.

Tragic events struck his family, much as they did in Job's family in the Old Testament. Scarlet fever killed his 4 year old son. Then, a year later, a major fire destroyed all of his belongings. Spafford had intended to travel to England with his family and visit great friend, evangelist Dwight L. Moody, two years later.


Due to a business agreement, he was unable to join his family, so he sent his wife and the four children, Anna (11 years), Margaret (9 years), Lee (5 years), and Tanetta (2 years), aboard the Ville du Havre (ship), unaware that further catastrophe would befall them.



Ville du Havre was travelling across the Atlantic when it was struck by an iron sailing ship and it sank into the deep sea within 12 minutes, killing 226 people, including his four loving daughters.

Anna Spafford, his wife, was one of the few survivors. "Saved alone, what to do?" she telegraphed her husband once the survivors arrived in Cardiff, South Wales.

On his way to visit his wife, Horatio Spafford was summoned to the deck by the Captain, who showed him the exact location where Ville du Havre had sank and where his daughters had perished.




The voyage was a painful one for Horatio and he went to his cabin and wrote,

When peace like a river, attendeth my way,
When sorrows like sea billows roll
Whatever my lot, thou hast taught me to say
It is well, it is well, with my soul.....

His faith in God never wavered amidst his grief and sorrow. Anna's half-sister received a telegram from Horatio saying, "On Thursday last, we passed over the spot where she went down, in mid-ocean, the waters three miles deep. But I do not think of our dear ones there. They are safe..... dear lambs".

Anna gave birth to three more children but one of the children died at the age of four. In 1881, Spaffords left America and settled in Jerusalem to serve and care for the sick, and took in homeless children. He died of Malaria in Jerusalem and his wife Anna continued to serve the people sharing God's love until she died. Surely, "It is well with their souls".

Horatio's friend Phillip Bliss composed music for the poem Horatio wrote and it was sung as a new hymn at Dwight L. Moody's crusades. Thus the hymn "It Is Well with My Soul" was birthed.



The largest Bible in the world weighs 1,094 pounds (496 kilograms). In the year 1930, Louis Waynai produced the Bible, devoting over 8,000 hours to reproducing the King James Version. When opened, Louis Waynai's Bible is 43.5 inches tall and spans 98 inches.



## The Sign of the Covenant

COVENANT was established by God and is administered by God. The Covenant's fulfillment is Abraham's obligation.

### a) EVERLASTING COVENANT

**Gen. 17:7 -** I will establish My covenant as an everlasting covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you, to be your God and the God of your descendants after you.

- 1. Nation of Israel was set apart
- 2. Divine revelation to the prophets
- 3. Nation will be a part of a covenant

### b) ETERNAL COVENANT

**Deut 10:16** - Circumcise your hearts, therefore, and do not be stiff-necked any longer.

Circumcise your heart and make a conscious decision to love God above all else. Don't be stubborn. Be willing to submit to God's authority.

### c) GRACIOUS COVENANT

**Deut 30: 6 -** The LORD your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your descendants, so that you may love him with all your heart and with all your soul, and live.

God's sovereign grace helps you to circumcise your heart so that you might love God and live eternally with Him. The Holy Spirit will convict you of sin and console you.

### d) DEMANDING COVENANT

**Jer 4:4** Circumcise yourselves to the Lord, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.

Circumcise yourself and remove your heart's foreskins, which have become insensitive to the WORD.

**Jer 9: 24 -** But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the Lord which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the Lord.

**Act 7: 51 -** You stiff-necked people! Your hearts and ears are still uncircumcised. You are just like your ancestors: You always resist the Holy Spirit! -Heart has been far from me.

**Rom 9: 28, 29 -** For a person is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is true circumcision something external and physical. 29 Rather, a person is a Jew who is one inwardly, and real circumcision is a matter of the heart—it is spiritual and not literal. Such a person receives praise not from others but from God.'


